



Adult AAC group

The Pinarc Adult AAC group is to provide a safe place for young adults with Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) to connect, interact and foster friendship alongside with their carers.

The group is designed to provide opportunities for adult AAC users to:

- Connect with peers using their communication device in a safe and supported group.
- Have a therapist to support their carers/support workers to facilitate their use of communication device.
- Use their communication device meaningfully across the week to interact and extend beyond the group with the support from their carers/support workers.

Requirements for individuals to participate:

- A carer/support worker will need to be present with the individual throughout the session. You are required to fund for your support worker to attend the program.
- Has a communication device.
- Age 18 and above

Weekly Monday starting 1/05/2023 until 26/06/2023. Once a week. (8 weeks)
