



Pinarc Parent Support Program

Providing free individual and group-based information and support to parent carers of children with disabilities. You do not have to be using any other Pinarc services, or have an NDIS plan.

Individual support:

We provide information and support to individual parents and carers of children with disabilities. Parent/guardian carers can call or email requests for information or support.

Information:

Carers registered with the program receive monthly updates about upcoming events and activities for children with disabilities and their families.

Support Groups

We facilitate and support several parent support and social connection groups for parent/guardian carers across the region.

Events

We run information sessions and workshops for carers. Through the Support for Carers program, we also run social activities for carers and families.
